Students should arrive on campus 5-10 minutes early so they have ample time to report to their first block class. Punctuality is incredibly important and it helps ensure continuity of instruction. Chronic tardiness will be addressed as outlined below. An unauthorized tardy is defined as when a student does not arrive to school on time without a note from a parent/caregiver explaining the tardiness. Unauthorized tardies cannot exceed two per semester. Administration reserves the right to limit tardy notes.

4 Tardies - 1 detention    8 Tardies - 2 detentions    12 Tardies - 2 detentions    16 Tardies - 2 detentions

\*\* Beyond 16 tardies, discipline will continue in increments of four and the student will be subject to Saturday detention, and/or Social Probation, and/or loss of parking privileges (Senior). Students tardy to class are subject to additional discipline and/or consequences. A cut will be issued if a student is 20 or more minutes late for any class.
